## Should ASSOCIATE CLINICIANS perform external cephalic version (ECV)?

Problem: Poor access to ECV

**Option**: Associated clinicians performing ECV

**Comparison**: Care delivered by other cadres or no care

Setting: Community/primary health care settings in LMICs with poor access to

health professionals

Recommendation	We recommend against the option	We suggest considering the option in the context of rigorous research	We recommend the option

Justification	There is insufficient evidence on the effectiveness of associate clinicians performing external cephalic version, the intervention is outside of their typical scope of practice and its acceptability and feasibility are uncertain.
