## **Should NURSES perform vasectomy?**

Problem: Poor access to contraception Option: Nurses performing vasectomy
Comparison: Care delivered by other cadres or no care

Setting: Community/primary health care settings in LMICs with poor access

to health professionals

Recommendation	We recommend against the option	We suggest considering the option only in the context of rigorous research	We recommend the option
	We suggest considering this option only in the context of rigorous research. This intervention should be evaluated where a well-functioning referral system is in place or can be put in place		
Justification	There is insufficient evidence on the effectiveness of this interventions. However, this intervention may be a cost-effective, acceptable and feasible approach to contraception and may also reduce inequalities by extending care to underserved populations.
